

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, GTEC, CAGD, SD DOMBO UNIVERSITY OF BUSINESS AND INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT STUDIES, CK TEDAM UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AND APPLIED SCIENCES


In the meeting with the Minister of Education, GTEC, Controller and Accountant General Department and leaders of worker Unions of SDD-UBIDS and CKT-UTAS on Tuesday, August 17, 2021, at the Ministry of Education, it was agreed as follows:

1. The Hon. Minister assured all stakeholders that he will facilitate the processes to ensure that all the agreements are met before the migration of the two Universities with all other public Universities.
2. That the Staff of SDD-UBIDS and CKT-UTAS will continue to receive their salaries through UDS until the conditions precedent to the migration as agreed by the National Union leaders, GTEC and CAGD are met
3. GTEC is to write to the two Universities to give them their codes for receiving subventions to process their own payrolls.


In view of the above, the Unions have resolved to suspend the strike with immediate effect.




